

Reighton Village Hall – Minutes of the 2019 Annual General Meeting
Held Wednesday 22nd May 2019 Commencing at 7pm

1. Minutes of last AGM

The minutes of the AGM held on 3rd May 2018 were circulated.
Accepted as a correct record. Carried.

2. Matters Arising from the Minutes

3. Chairman/Secretary's Report:

The Chairman reported on another successful trading year with the village hall in regular use by a number of groups: Zoe's Children's Dance Training Sessions; the Tuesday Pilates Class; monthly meetings of Bridlington Canine Society; Parish Council meetings.

In addition to the monthly coffee mornings and the fortnightly Craft and Chat, there were the regular church fundraisers (Church Fair; Craft Fair), the McMillan event in September, and Bloom Best Kept Garden Competition.

There have been a number of successful social events organised during the year such as Quiz nights (thanks to Keith Scruton), Beetle Drive & History Night. Special Thanks also goes to Bet & Jon Wright for the remembrance event.

We had had very little in interest for private hire, but that notwithstanding, it was good to see the hall being regularly used.

Thanks are due to Pat Cross for organising the coffee mornings, Pat has now stood down from the committee but Bet Wright will continue to organise these, to Anne Hinchliffe for collecting the bonus ball subscriptions and organising the cleaning rota; and to all who supported us by coming to events and contributing books, raffle prizes etc.

Thanks also go to Doreen Goodall; Judy Triffitt; Diana Lawton & Laura Grey who have all served on the committee in the last year but have now stood down.

4. Treasurer's Report

Mrs Hinchliffe had provided a financial report for the year ended 31st March 2019 showing income for the year of £3744.92, including £1582.00 hire fees and £1,459 from the Lottery. Expenditure was £3666.75, including £1286.24 spent on a new fence. Overall, there was a surplus of income over expenditure of £78.17, increasing our year-end bank balances to £8,717.58CR.

5. Election of Chairman

Paul Riley asked if anyone would like to take over the role of chairman. No one volunteered so Paul agreed to do the job again for another Year, but he stated that it would be in a reduced capacity. It was then agreed that in order to drive the social events forward that a sub committee would be formed for the social events.

6. Election of Officers & Committee

8. Social Programme

It was agreed that a sub-committee would be formed to run the social events at the Village Hall.

It was agreed that social events should be self funding.

9. AOB

Fencing:

As previously agreed the fencing posts and wire keeping out the sheep in the adjacent field were now in a serious state of disrepair with many of the posts starting to rot and so needed replacement. A new fence has been installed and the play area has been cordoned off to stop cars parking on the play area.

Driveway/Parking Area:

No further work will be carried out on the parking area. The purchase of rubber mats has made a big difference to the amount of stones being walked into the hall.
