Police and Fire and Rescue to host Filey Emergency Services Fun Day

An Emergency Services Fun Day is being organised in Filey to provide a platform for all of the 'Blue Light' services to display their appliances, equipment and skills to the public in a safe, controlled environment.

The event will take place on Filey Playing Fields on Sunday 22nd August from 11am to 4pm.

This great family day out is being organised by Filey and Eastfield Police and Scarborough Fire and Rescue Service in collaboration with Filey Lions and Filey Playing Fields Association. Blue Light organisations taking part will include Yorkshire Ambulance, Yorkshire Air Ambulance, the RNLI and Scarborough Mountain Rescue supported by many local organisation's which are integral to the work of the emergency services.



The day is a chance for members of the public of all ages to meet the hugely diverse range of the North of England's Emergency Services teams, all in one location. These teams are a combination of both full time and also volunteer members contributing their valuable skills in emergencies.

On display will be a colourful array of specialist vehicles and expertise ranging from volunteer mountain rescue teams, Yorkshire Air Ambulance, fire engines, police cars and police firearms and dogs teams.



The famous Yorkshire Air Ambulance is also expected to drop in.

One of the exciting demonstrations will feature the story of a serious road traffic accident from the experience of four different people – a member of each of the emergency services and an actor playing the part of the person involved in the accident. The fire services part of the demonstration will show how they release the driver by removing the roof of the car.



The emergency services day is a fun, family friendly event. On the day itself, officers and police volunteers will be running stalls filled with a variety of information on young drivers – road safety, cybercrime, and general safety.
